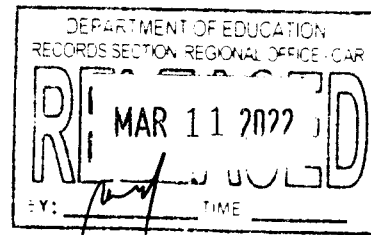

**ONLINE REGIONAL CONTESTS FOR LEARNERS WITH DISABILITIES CUM REGIONAL
 DISABILITY PREVENTION AND REHABILITATION WEEK**

1. The Department of Education – Cordillera Administrative Region (DepED-CAR) through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) will be conducting the **Online Regional Contests for Learners with Disabilities cum Regional Disability Prevention and Rehabilitation Week**.

2. The objectives of this activity are to:
 a. showcase skills and talents of Learners with Disabilities (LWDs);
 b. develop/Strengthen sportsmanship among the learners; and
 c. increase collaboration between and among teachers and parents.

3. Schools Division Offices (SDOs) shall conduct a Division-wide online contest following the Mechanics stipulated in Paragraph 4. The First Place winners for each category shall be the entries for the regional level online contest. Each SDO shall submit 3 entries summarized below:

4. Please be guided by the general contest guidelines/mechanics:
 a. Contestants are currently enrolled in the public elementary schools and SPED Centers for SY 2021 – 2022 and tagged in the Learners’ Information System (LIS) as **Children with Hearing Impairment (CHI) for Poster Making, Children with Visual Impairment (CVI) for Solo Singing and Children with Intellectual Disability (CID) – NON-GRADED for Dance Category**. However, if the learners are not tagged in the LIS, an assessment record from the psychometrician or medical doctors may suffice.
 b. Contestant is allowed to participate in **ONE** category only.





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- c. The contestant is given freedom to choose his/her own contest piece in Solo Singing either English or Filipino while “Macarena” will be used for Dance Category.
- d. The theme of 2021 National Disability Prevention and Rehabilitation (NDPR) Week, “*Kalusugan at Kaunlaran ng Pilipinong may Kapansanan, Isulong sa Gitna ng Pandemya*” will be used as theme for the Poster Making. Further, pre – outlined drawing is NOT allowed. The activity shall be given a maximum of 2 hours duration which shall be recorded through video. Final output and video shall be submitted to the Regional Office on or before June 15, 2022.
- e. Entries for Solo and Dance shall be submitted through video with maximum resolution of 720p (16:9) to optimal 1080p (16:9) and shall be saved in .vmw, .mov, .mp4, or .mpg file format.
- f. Mechanics in the conduct of the contest per category shall be followed strictly.
- g. Winners per category will be identified by the Board of Judges.
- h. All winners will receive cash prize and Certificates of Recognition and Certificates of Participation for non-winners. Teachers/Coaches will receive Certificates of Recognition/Participation. Below is the summary for Cash Prize:
- First Prize : Php 3, 000.00
Second Prize : Php 2, 500.00
Third Prize : Php 2, 000.00
- i. The decision of the board of judges is final.
5. The winners for each category will be chosen based on the following criteria:
