**MASS TRAINING OF SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL TEACHERS IN THE ACADEMIC TRACKS**

**TO: Schools Division Superintendents  
Heads, Public and Private Secondary Schools  
All Others Concerned**

1. In line with Republic Act (RA) No. 10533 or the Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013 and the implementation of the K to 12 Basic Education Program, the Department of education will conduct the Senior High School (SHS) Mass Training of Teachers (MTOT) in the Academic Tracks from May 30 to June 11, 2016.
2. The objective of this activity is to provide teachers with concrete understanding of the Curriculum Frameworks, Learning Standards and Competencies, Teaching Plans and Assessments.
3. Participants to this activity are all Senior High School Teachers who will handle the Academic Track which includes the strands in Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM), Accountancy & Business Management (ABM), Humanities and Social Sciences (HUMSS) and General Academic Strands (GAS). The following are the expected number of participants from SDOs and are requested to proceed to the training venue on Day 0 of the training for the Opening Program.

8. Teachers shall be given nine (9) days service credits while Regional Supervisors who will act as monitors will be entitled to CTOs in lieu of June 4,5, and 11 (Saturday and Sunday) as per CSC and DBM Joint Circular No. 2,s.2015.

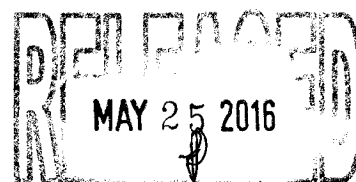
