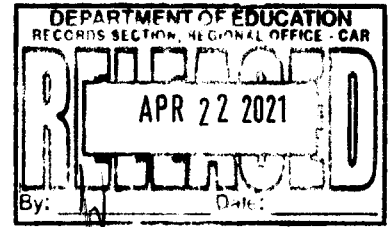

To also strengthen awareness of our initiatives relative to the Whole-of-Nation Approach or EO 70 cum Project Salaknib Tan Namnama, **all activities, assistance, and partnerships with other national agencies, non-government organizations (NGOs) or civic groups must be documented and uploaded via the SDO's official DepEd Tayo page or Facebook Page and shall be accompanied with the hashtags - #CICIWIT #DepEdCARELCAC #SalaknibTanNamnama.**

DATE : 13 APRIL 2021

This refers to the implementation of the Retooled Community Support Program (RCSP) wherein 79 barangays in the Cordillera Administrative Region are identified by the National Task Force on Ending Local Communist Armed Conflict (NTF-ELCAC) to undergo the RCSP process for FY 2021.

Each covered barangay is expected to implement the RCSP work plan in compliance to DILG Memorandum Circular Nos. 2019-169 and 2020-095 before the end of this year. A copy of the RCSP checklist indicating the activities, its expected results (outputs), and timeline for the operationalization of RCSP is attached for your reference.

In view hereof, as agreed by the members of the RTF-ELCAC Technical Working Group and Secretariat during the meeting last March 10, 2021, member-agencies were requested to fill-up the Convergence Plan for the RCSP implementation through the Google Sheets. The link for the online spreadsheet is: tinyurl.com/RCSPConvergence.

The Convergence Plan consists of the steps and activities under the phases of the RCSP. The agency/focal person/encoder shall input the details of any related activities to each phase. The data posted in the plan will be consolidated and organized in preparation for the conduct of series of Serbisyo Caravans in targeted barangays by the RTF-ELCAC.

Attached is the list of target barangays for information and uniformity of target beneficiaries on the services and other interventions being provided by the regional line agencies and provincial counterparts in support to ending local communist armed conflict.

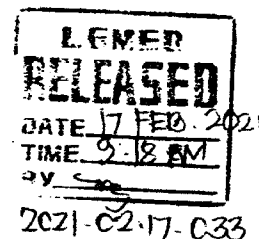
