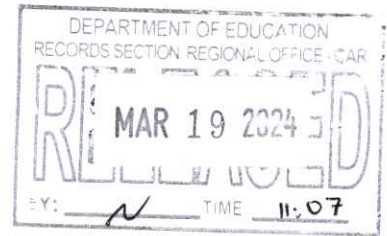

**REGIONAL MEMORANDUM**

**SUBMISSION OF PARTICIPANTS TO THE REGIONAL TRAINING OF TRAINERS ON THE MATATAG CURRICULUM**

To: All Schools Division Superintendents  
All Other Concerned

1. This Office shall conduct the RTOT on the MaTaTaG Curriculum on March 31-April 5, 2024 in Baguio City at a venue to be announced later.
2. The activity is designed to provide professional development support to teachers and school leaders by equipping them with the necessary knowledge, skills, and competencies to ensure that they have an in-depth understanding of the general shape of the MATATAG Curriculum needed to effectively implement the new curriculum.
3. The eight (8) Schools Division Offices (SDOs), through the Human Resource Development Section, in collaboration with the Curriculum Implementation Division, shall endorse participants, depending on the SDOs allocation (Enclosure 1). Participants must be CID and SGOD Chiefs, SDO EPS, PSDS and School Heads with the following qualifications:
  - a. Must have at least earned Complete Academic Requirements (CAR);
  - b. Must be a content expert in the learning areas of Filipino, English, Science, Mathematics, social Science, EPP/TLE, MAPEH, and Values Education/GMRC;
  - c. Must have training/s related to the area of specialization;
  - d. For Kindergarten and Grade 1, participants must be an expert in literacy and numeracy; and
  - e. Must have at least Very Satisfactory performance in the last three (3) years.
4. In addition, the SDO-HRDS SEPS shall ensure that endorsed participants fills-up the profiling link via **<https://tinyurl.com/TOTmatatagCAR>** before **March 19, 2024** to ensure alignment to pre-training logistics.
5. Board and lodging, materials, supplies and travel expenses of participants shall be charged to 2024 Downloaded HRD Funds for Training on the MATATAG Curriculum for Teachers and School Leaders, subject to



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the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. In the event that the downloaded fund is not enough, other travel expenses shall be charged to local funds.

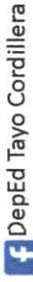
