

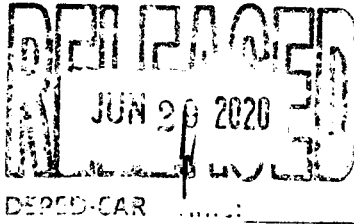

DEPED-CAR REGIONAL POLICY GUIDELINES ON STUDENT DISCIPLINE

To: OIC-Assistant Regional Director
Schools Division Superintendents
Public and Private Elementary and Secondary School Heads
Heads of SUCs, LUCs offering basic education
All others concerned

1. Department of Education – CAR issues the enclosed Regional Manual on student discipline entitled "***GENDER RESPONSIVE AND NON-DISCRIMINATORY STUDENT DISCIPLINE MANUAL (GRaNdSDisM)***" which can be adopted by the schools as their manual or may serve as the basis of all public and private schools in crafting, developing or amending their Learners' Discipline Manual, Anti-Bullying Policy, and Child Protection Policy.
2. This policy guidelines, which is based from the Constitution, international convention, statutes, and DepEd issuances, provide the minimum standards that shall be included in the above mentioned policies and manual.
3. All regional policies, processes or systems related to learners' discipline that are inconsistent to this Regional Memorandum are hereby repealed, rescinded, or modified accordingly.
4. This policy shall take effect after 15 days from publication in the DepEd CAR website.
5. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum are directed.
