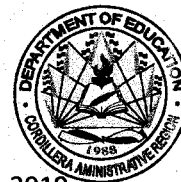


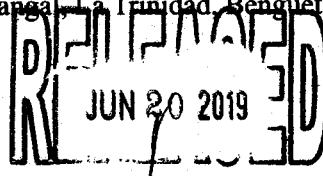

SEARCH FOR 2019 BRIGADA ESKWELA BEST-IMPLEMENTING SCHOOLS

To: Schools Division Superintendents
Heads, Public Elementary and Secondary Schools
All Others Concerned

1. The **Search for 2019 Brigada Eskwela Best Implementing Schools** is conducted every school year, to give due recognition to schools whose efforts in the implementation of Brigada Eskwela is commendable.
2. To effectively implement the selection process in the **Search for Brigada Eskwela Best Implementing Schools**, this Office issues a set of criteria, and details in the selection of Brigada Eskwela Best Implementing Schools.
3. The Brigada Eskwela Best Implementing Schools are categorized into four (4): (a) Small School Category; (b) Medium School Category; (c) Large School Category; and, (d) Mega School Category for both elementary and secondary levels.
4. There shall be eight (8) entries per Schools Division: two (2) small category with 9 and below number of teachers, for both elementary and secondary levels; two (2) medium school category with 10-29 number of teachers for elementary level and 10-25 number of teachers for secondary level; two (2) large school category with 30-50 number of teachers for elementary level and 26-50 for secondary level; and, two (2) mega school category with 51 and above number of teachers for both elementary and secondary levels. Each category shall have one (1) entry for elementary level and one (1) for secondary level. **Please refer to DepEd Memorandum No. 036, s. 2019 for the other criteria of selection and information.**
5. **The deadline for submission of all entries C/o Education Support Services Division (ESSD) this Office will be on or before July 19, 2019.** The timeline of Brigada Eskwela activities and the selection criteria on the Search for the Brigada Eskwela Best Implementing Schools shall be followed strictly by all concerned.
6. Monitoring /evaluation/validation of all entries shall be conducted on July-August, 2019 by the Regional Monitoring Team.
7. Submission of Schools Division Consolidated Brigada Eskwela Accomplishment Report to the External Partnerships Service, Central Office via email to externalpartnerships@deped.gov.ph and copy furnished this Office will be on or before July 26, 2019.
8. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is earnestly desired.
