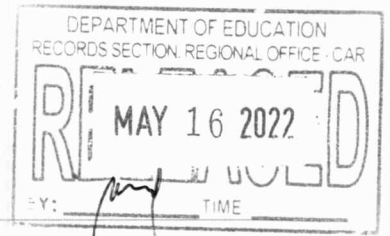

**CALL FOR ENTRIES FOR THE SEAMEO-JAPAN EDUCATION FOR
 SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT AWARD 2022**

1. The office invites all the Schools Division Offices, particularly the public and private schools, to send entries for the Southeast Asian Ministers of Education Organization-Japan Education for Sustainable Development (SEAMEO-Japan ESD) Award with the theme “Education Transformation through Partnership”.

2. The SEAMEO-Japan ESD Award is conducted annually with different themes since 2012 and participated by Southeast Asian schools. Last year, five (5) finalist/shortlisted schools and twelve (12) participating schools were recognized by the SEAMEO through the efforts of the regional office’s “Edukasyong SAPAT at DAPAT para sa Bata Project” (RM No. 292, s. 2021)¹.

3. The objectives of the SEAMEO-Japan ESD Award are:
- a. to raise awareness of ESD in schools and communities;
 - b. to promote ESD best practices in schools and communities;
 - c. to share and exchange knowledge and best practices on ESD in schools;
 - d. to encourage networking among schools and communities which implement ESD practices; and,
 - e. to support the DepEd’s effort on the achievement of United Nation’s Sustainable Development Goals.

4. For quality assessed and organized facilitation of entries, the regional office shall conduct a regional level Search prior to the submission of entries to the SEAMEO-Japan Secretariat. The Search shall follow the schedule of activities below:

5. Each SDO shall select and submit five (5) entries (2 private schools and 3 public schools) for the regional search. The office shall utilize the submission form, guidelines for submission of entries and judging criteria of the SEAMEO-Japan ESD Award. Full information and downloadable forms are available at <https://link.seameo.org/2022SEAMEOJapanESDAward>. Entries (submission form and 3-minute video clip in MP4 format) shall be submitted to car.ftad@deped.gov.ph on or before June 30, 2022.
