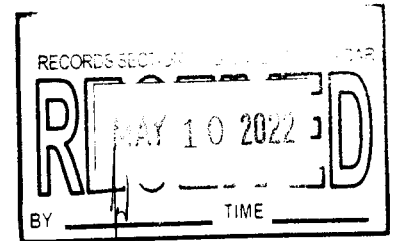

Dear Dir. Cariño:

The Bureau of Learning Delivery-Teaching and Learning Division (BLD-TLD) is scheduled to conduct a 4-day field monitoring on the implementation of the expanded limited face-to-face classes on **May 30 to June 3, 2022**. The following education program specialists are assigned in your region to hold classroom observations and focus group discussion with select teachers:

1. Joseph Randolph P. Palattao – Supervising Education Program Specialist
2. Ronnie M. Baldos – Senior Education Program Specialist
3. Lea D. Estuye – Senior Education Program Specialist

They will also conduct Key Informant Interviews (KII) with the school heads of the same schools where they will observe with the education supervisors in the same division. The classroom observations and focus group discussion will primarily focus on how teachers maximize their interaction with learners and utilize strategies and techniques so that continuity of learning is achieved in home-based and classroom-based activities. Whereas, the KII with the school heads and supervisors will focus on the forms of technical assistance that they have provided to teachers including the challenges and highlights of the expanded phase of limited face-to-face classes. Further, sample Weekly Learning Plan and Learning Progress Checklist may also be collected from select teachers, as these documents may provide additional information on how teachers manage and monitor learning.

In this light, may we seek your approval to proceed with the field monitoring in your region, specifically in the Schools Division Offices of **Kalinga, Ifugao and Tabuk City**. May we further request that the selected SDOs, in turn, identify the schools which will be the focus of the monitoring. May we also request for regional supervisors to join the monitoring team in the conduct of such activities.
