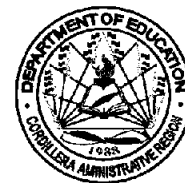





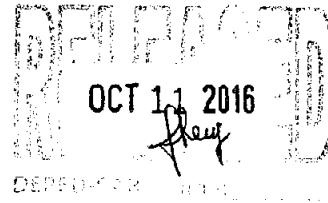

1. Pursuant to DepEd Advisory No. 265, s. 2016, The Philippine Association for Values Education (PAVE)/Pambansang Samahan Para sa Edukasyon sa Pagpapahalaga (PSEP) Inc. will hold its First International Convention on Values Education from December 2 to 4, 2016 at the Crown Legacy Hotel, Baguio City.
2. Relative to this, DepEd CAR, through the Curriculum & Learning Management Division (CLMD) will hold the following competitions on Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao on November 22, 2016 at the NEAP-R, DepEd, CAR, Wangal, La Trinidad, Benguet; 2016 Regional Esp Tagis Talino, Poster Making and Sayawit competition and Awarding of Outstanding Esp Teacher.
3. Submit names of Division winners (one from elementary and one from Junior High School) through hard copy or email to [clmd.depedcar@gmail.com](mailto:clmd.depedcar@gmail.com) on or before November 14, 2016.
4. Refer to DepEd Advisory No. 265, s. 2016 for the mechanics & procedures of the competitions.
5. The **EsP 2016 Regional Search for Outstanding Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (EsP) Teacher** will use the attached guidelines during the 2015 PSEP Annual Nationwide Search for Outstanding School-Based Values Education/Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao Program.
6. All pertinent documents of the Division winners for Outstanding EsP Teacher (one winner from the elementary and one from the Junior High school level) in each schools division office will be evaluated and validated by a structured Regional committee composed of two Education Prog. Supervisors & the CLMD chief as chairman.
7. Transportation and other incidental expenses of the participants will be charged to local funds while lodging and food (breakfast, lunch, & snacks) will be charged to Regional funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
8. First meal will be breakfast and last meal will be PM snack on November 22, 2016.
9. Immediate dissemination of and compliance to this Memorandum is desired.

**2016 Contest Mechanics for Tagis-Talino, Sayawit and Poster-Making**

1. Contestants must be bona fide pupils / students of Philippine schools for the current school year and registered participants to the First International Convention on VE / 2016 KPSEP National Convention.
2. Each Region / Division / District could send the Top Five competing teams (Tagis-Talino), performing groups (Sayawit), and participants (On-the-Spot Poster-Making) of the Region/ Division / District Level Elimination. In the absence of eliminations in such levels, the schools may directly participate in the National Level.
3. Participants coming from the state universities, local colleges and private schools are considered national contestants, hence, need not participate in the region/ division /district elimination.
4. The participants should submit a certification duly signed by proper authorities, bearing the names of the contestants and their alternates, and the name of the trainers/coaches with their full mailing address and contact number.

**Rules of the Contest - TAGIS-TALINO**

1. The teams will compete in the Easy (1pt), Average (3pts), and the Difficult (5pts) categories.
2. There will be 10 questions per category that relate to the contents of EsP 7, 8, 9 & 10.
3. The quizmaster will read the questions twice and the team will be given 15 seconds to write the answer on the answer sheet then wait for the quizmaster's signal to raise their answers. The scorers will check the answers and tally the scores on the scoreboard.
4. The three teams with the highest scores will be declared as winners.  
(Champion, 1st runner up, and 2nd runner up)
5. In case of a tie, the quizmaster will ask a new set of three questions. The team with the highest score will automatically be declared as the winner.
6. Cash prizes and trophies await the winner.

**Rules of the Contest - SAYAWIT**

**(ELEMENTARY DIVISION (Grades 4-6). SECONDARY DIVISION (Grades 7-10))**

1. Sayawit presentation must be relevant to the convention theme.
2. Presentation time should not exceed 10 minutes excluding entrance, exit, and other preparations for stage.
3. Number of performers on stage should be from 7 - 10 (singers and dancers) excluding technical assistants, who are singing and dancing at the same time.
4. Contestants may use props and other stage sets.
5. Live accompaniment is required, and no lip-synchs.
6. Costumes must be appropriate to the movements.

2	Choreography	25%
3	Musicality	25%
4	Props and costumes	10%
5	Over-all staging Impact	10%

**Rules of the Contest - ON-THE-SPOT POSTER-MAKING**

**(ELEMENTARY DIVISION (Grades 4-6). SECONDARY DIVISION (Grades 7-10))**

1. Contestants are advised to bring their own materials.
  - a.  $\frac{3}{4}$  illustration board, pencil, pastel / craypass
2. Contestants are given 3 hours to finish the work.
3. Letterings and borders are not allowed as part of the presentation.

OUTSTANDING SCHOOL-BASED VALUES EDUCATION /

**Rationale / Objective:** Recognize the outstanding achievements and efforts of schools and institutions in sustaining and strengthening the National Values Education Program.

**Guidelines for Implementation:** The search is open to all elementary and secondary schools both public and private, duly nominated by their respective region / division / district head using the prescribed nomination form.

**Awards and Prizes:** The winner shall receive the following awards and prizes:

1. Plaque of Recognition.
2. Cash Prize.

The awarding ceremony will coincide with the PSEP National Convention on November 29-30 and Dec. 1, 2015.

**Qualification and Nomination**

1. The school nominee must be presently offering Values Education / EsP both as a separate subject area and as integrated in the core subjects for the last three (3) years or more.
2. The school nominee must be recommended by the region / division or district.
3. Nominees and Finalists in the previous year's search (except the winners) are still qualified for re-nomination.

**Selection Procedure:**

1. For the first level. All supporting documents (within the last three (3) years submitted by the school nominees shall be rated according to a set of criteria presented below:

<b>Outstanding Implementation of the Values Education Program</b> <i>(well-managed VE program, introduced innovations in teaching VE, conducted researches, prepared instructional materials in VE and received awards and recognition)</i>	40%
<b>Faculty Professional Development Program</b> <i>(qualified teaching staff, provided professional development program, attended Values Education training programs, members of PSEP)</i>	20%
<b>Student Development Program</b> <i>(well-organized KPSEP group, supported various students' activities - youth for a seminar, convention, etc.)</i>	20%
<b>Community Involvement and School Leadership</b> <i>(conducted and participated in community projects and reach out programs, mobilized the community for Values Development)</i>	20%
	<b>100%</b>

2. The top three (3) ranking nominees shall be declared as the **National Finalists**.

**Final Selection:**

Rating based on the First level selection .....	40%
On-the-Spot School Visit .....	30%
On-the-Spot Interview with the Stakeholders .....	30%
<i>(immediate barangay, students and parents)</i>	100%

**Documents to be submitted by the School Nominee in the following order (within the last three (3) years)**

1. Duly accomplished Nomination forms (3 copies)
2. School Portfolio (brief history of the school, administration, staff and enrollment trend)
3. Program of Teaching Schedule (for the last three (3) years)
4. List of Innovations done in the Teaching of Values Education with supporting documents.
5. Profile of Faculty and their corresponding Educational Qualification with supporting documents.
6. List of Faculty Professional Development (attendance in training programs, workshops, etc.)
7. List of Student Activities with supporting documents.
8. List of Community Involvement and Leadership with supporting documents.
