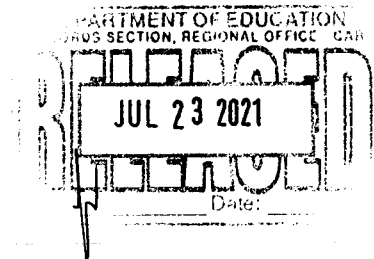

1. Use any medium. Design should be drawn on a ¼ (20"x15") illustration board.
2. Indicate category and disaster type.
3. Put titles and captions.
4. Contest entries should be covered in plastic upon submission.

WINNERS

Two (2) major prize winners and four winners from each category will be selected.
Winner will be informed through phone or letter, and will be awarded in an online event (date to be announced).
Major prize winners will get P5,000 each. Other winners will receive P1,000 each.
Prizes not claimed within six (6) months will be forfeited.
Winning posters shall become CDRC property and will be featured in the 2020 CDRC Calendar and other promotional materials.
Non-winning entries can be reclaimed at the CDRC office. Entries not claimed within 60 days after the announcement of winners shall be considered donations to CDRC.

CONTEST LIMITS

Each participant can submit a maximum of two (2) entries.
Two-time winners of previous ABKD competitions can no longer join.
Posters that have won or have been submitted to other contests will not be accepted.
