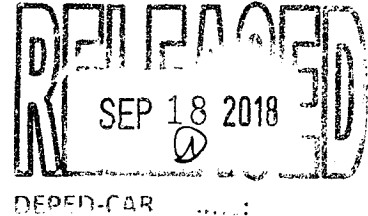

**Revisiting and Strengthening the Implementation of Alternative Delivery Modes
(ADMs)**

Regional Memorandum

309.2018



**TO: Schools Division Superintendents
All Divisions**

1. The Second Quarter of 2018 Regional Monitoring, Evaluation and Adjustment (RMEA) Report states among others that DepEd-CAR is still challenged with the increase of dropouts and failures among our learners both in elementary and secondary. To address this concerns, all SDOs are hereby directed to Revisit and Strengthen the Implementation of Alternative Delivery Modes (ADMs).
2. Policy Guidelines on ADMs through DepEd order No. 54, s. 2012, recognizes the Alternative Delivery Mode as tried and tested alternative of education delivery within the confines of the formal system that allow schools to deliver quality education to marginalized students and those at risk of dropping out in order to help them overcome personal, social and economic constraints in their schooling. These modalities include the following:
 - a. E-IMPACT-Enhanced Instructional Management by Parents, Community and Teachers
 - b. MISOSA- Modified In-School Off-School Approach
 - c. OHSP- Open High School Program (e.g. Project EASE/Home Study Program/Blended Learning)
 - d. Other local initiatives
