

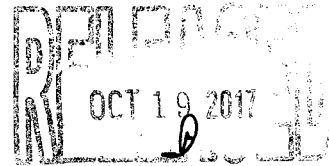

1. Relative to the conduct of the 2017 Regional IPEd Congress scheduled on October 23 to 25, 2017, please be informed that the venue for the Opening Ritual will be at the Dap-ay, Regional Office Compound while the Program will be at the NEAPR Conference Hall. Opening Ritual will start at 7:45 in the morning and the Program at 9:00 AM.
2. All panel sessions for October 23 will be conducted at the NEAPR Conference Hall. Venue for Parallel sessions on October 24 will be announced on Day 1.
3. Exhibits will be at designated booths outside NEAP. Displays will focus on evidences of Division initiatives in the effective implementation of all K to 12 Programs. It may include unique products found in respective communities under the One Town, One Product (OTOP) program. SDOs may start fixing from October 21 to 22 (Saturday and Sunday).
4. Schools Division Offices are requested to register participants following the link provided for in paragraph 5 of RM 288. Each Division is allotted 49 slots with breakdown detailed in paragraph 4.
5. Moreover, each SDO will share in the provision of snacks for the duration of the Congress following this schedule as agreed upon during the planning activity:
October 23: AM snack-Abra and Apayao, PM snack-Kalinga and Tabuk City;
October 24: AM snack-Benguet, PM snack-Ifugao and Mountain Province;
