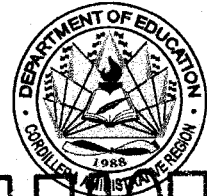



NATIONAL TRAINING IN SPORTS COACHING FOR DEVELOPMENTAL LEVEL (BATCH 2)

TO : All Schools Division Superintendents
All Concerned

1. The National Training in Coaching for Developmental Level (Batch 2) shall be conducted in Pangasinan Development and training Center, Pangasinan on November 6 to 10, 2017 (First dinner is November 5).
2. The objectives of this training is: to capacitate the regional and division coaches and trainers on the current trends, scientific coaching and training techniques in their respective sport discipline. The Developmental Level is designed to help coaches implement developmentally appropriate training programs to improve technical ability. It covers the role of the coach, methodology and player development.
3. The participants (enclosed list) are required to submit the following during the registration:
 - a. Medical certification from a government physician that he/she is medically and physically fit;
 - b. Certification from the school principal or from the schools division superintendent that he/she is presently coaching a team ;
 - c. an evidence showing that he/she is has at least five years coaching experience.
 - d. furthermore, participants are required to bring their personal sports equipment, and to wear proper sports attire during the conduct of this training.
4. Board and lodging shall be charged to DepEd-Central Office while transportation and other incidental expenses of participants shall be charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.



SUBJECT : NATIONAL TRAINING IN SPORTS COACHING FOR
 INTERMEDIATE LEVEL (BATCH 1) AND DEVELOPMENTAL LEVEL
 (BATCH 2)

DATE : October 2, 2017

1. As a mandate of the School Sports Division of the Bureau of Learner Support Services, **National Training in Sports Coaching for Intermediate Level (Batch 1) and Developmental Level (Batch 2)** shall be conducted in Lingayen, Pangasinan I on October 16-20, 2017 and November 6-10, 2017, respectively.

2. The **Intermediate Level** training is designed to assist coaches in their coaching techniques and tactics. The course focuses on the principles of play, the roles of players, and the fundamental of training programs while the **Developmental Level** is designed to help coaches implement developmentally appropriate training programs to improve technical ability. This course covers the role of the coach, methodology and player development. The main objective of these trainings is to capacitate the regional and division coaches and trainers on the current trends, scientific coaching, and training techniques in their respective sport discipline.

3. The participants to these trainings are shown below:

Activity	Participants
1. National Training in Sports Coaching for Intermediate Level (Batch 1)	The attendees of the <i>National Training in Sports Coaching-Developmental Level</i> held at the Teachers Camp, Baguio City last July 25-29, 2016 shall compose the participants in this training. Neither those whose names are not included in the list nor replacements shall be allowed to participate.
2. National Training in Sports Coaching for Developmental Level (Batch 2)	Forty-eight (48) coaches per region preferably the teacher-coaches and trainers who would best represent their public high schools offering the sports track in the regions shall compose this training. Participants shall be required to submit the following: a) certification from the school principal or from the schools division superintendent that he/she is presently coaching a team; b) an evidence showing that he/she has at least five (5) years coaching experience; and c) a medical certification from a government physician that he/she is medically and physically fit.

4. Likewise, participants who are pregnant are not advised to attend the trainings.
5. Furthermore, participants are required to bring their personal sports equipment, and to wear proper attire during the conduct of these trainings.
6. The regional office shall submit list of participants (developmental level) using the enclosed form not later than October 30, 2017 to the **Project Secretariat, BLSS-SSD**. The schedule of activities and the required number of participants per sport and region are contained in the enclosure.
7. Expenses for these trainings such as board and lodging, training kit, honoraria of resource speakers, traveling expenses of management staff and resource persons, rental of venues and transport vehicles, office and sport supplies and equipment, and other incidental expenses shall be charged to the 2016 continuing fund under the Physical Fitness and School Sports Competition, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. However, traveling expenses of all participants shall be charged to local funds.
