



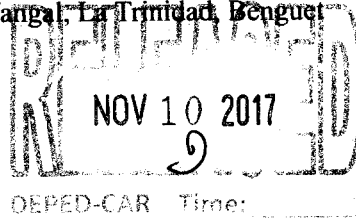

BRIGADA ESKWELA SA MARAWI (BESM)

TO: Schools Division Superintendents

1. With the official declaration of the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) on the end of the Marawi siege, the Brigada Eskwela Sa Marawi (BESM) can already be implemented by Department of Education.
2. A BESM Kick-off will be conducted on December 11, 2017 in Amai Pakpak Central Elementary School (APCES), Datu Akader Street, Brgy Buadi Sacayo Green, Marawi City while the actual conduct of the BESM will be held on December 12-13, 2017. However, it must be noted that the BESM is not included in the list of allowable expenses for the utilization of the MOOE of regions and schools divisions.
3. Schools Division Offices are highly encouraged to mobilize resources, materials and supplies needed to implement the intended assistance to Angoyao NHS and Calocan ES during the conduct of the BESM. List of materials and supplies needed by the said schools will be provided after the assessment of the engineers in the cleared areas.
4. For the BESM, DepEd-CAR is paired with Region XI and the Schools Division of BASULTA. While it was initially agreed during the 2nd MANCOM meeting held on August 11, 2017 at Palm Grove, Asin Road, Tuba, Benguet that whatever resources sourced out by the region will be equally shared by the two schools assigned to CAR, it was recommended that four (4) Schools Divisions will take charge of each school as follows:

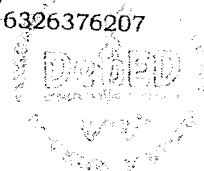
SUBJECT : **DAMAGE ASSESSMENT AND BRIGADA ESKWELA SA MARAWI IMPLEMENTATION AND KICK-OFF**

Relative to the recent announcement of the AFP that the Marawi City Siege is officially concluded, the Brigada Eskwela sa Marawi (BESM) may already be implemented. However, due to issues of safety and the need for the military to clear remaining areas of unexploded ordnances and improvised explosive devices, the BESM will have to be implemented by phases. The first phase will be the initial 12 schools that have already opened (see Annex A for the List of the 12 schools with their Regional and Division Twins/Pairs), and other schools that will possibly open in the coming weeks, the list of which we shall be providing once the military clears them for opening.

In light of this, a BESM Kick-off will be conducted on 11 December in Amai Pakpak Central Elementary School (APCES), Datu Akader Street, Brgy. Buadi Sacayo Green, Marawi City while the actual conduct of the BESM will be held on 12-13 December. However, it must be noted that the BESM is not included in the list of allowable expenses for the utilization of the MOOE of regions and divisions. In response to this, all regions and divisions are highly recommended to mobilize resources/materials/supplies to be able to implement the intended assistance to paired/twinned Marawi City schools during the conduct proper of the BESM. 
