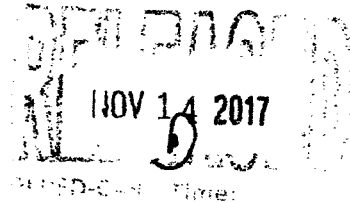

2018 REGIONAL SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE (RSPC)



To: **All Schools Division Superintendents
 Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools**

1. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1, Rule IX of Republic Act 7079, also known as *Campus Journalism Act of 1991*, the Department of Education – Cordillera Administrative Region (DepEd – CAR) announces the conduct of the 2018 Regional Schools Press Conference with the theme, **“Embracing ASEAN Integration: Campus Journalists’ Role In Advancing Inclusive Education”**, to be held at Stephen Capuyan Hall, Regional Office on December 1-4, 2017 for the School Paper contest and the Individual and Group contests will be in Tabuk City on December 5-8, 2017.

2. The conference aims to:
- a. Demonstrate understanding of the importance of journalism by expressing it through varied journalistic endeavors and approaches;
 - b. Sustain advocacy on social consciousness;
 - c. Provide a venue for enriching learning experience for students interested in pursuing journalism as a career;
 - d. Promote responsible journalism and fair and ethical use of social media; and
 - e. Enhance journalistic competence through healthy and friendly competitions.

3. The conference activities shall include the following in two levels: elementary and secondary, and of two media: English and Filipino:
- a. Individual Contests;
 - b. School Paper Contest
 - c. Radio Script Writing and Broadcasting Contest
 - d. TV Script Writing and Broadcasting Contests (for Secondary level)
 - e. Collaborative Desktop Publishing (CDP) Contest
 - f. Concurrent Sessions
 - g. Awarding of the Winners; the Outstanding School Paper Advisers (SPAs); and Campus Journalists (CJs), among others

4. The deadline for the submission of the top 10 School Paper entries per section/level/media and supporting documents including the division rating sheets of candidates for the Top 2 Outstanding School Paper Advisers and Campus Journalists from each division will be on or before November 30, 2017. Other contests listed below including reports for both levels and media shall be submitted to the Regional Office on or before November 24, 2017.

- a. List of the Top 5 Individual Winners per category
- b. List of Radio Script Writing and Broadcasting Contestants
- c. List of TV Script Writing and Broadcasting Contestants
- d. List of Collaborative Desktop Publishing Contestants
- e. Top 10 Winners per section in the Group Contests accompanied by a List of division School Paper entries

5. Technical Working Group for school paper contest must be at the Venue on December 1, 2017 with breakfast as the first meal and last meal will be dinner of December 4, 2017.

5. The members of the Group Contest Display Committee are requested to be in the Regional Office on December 1-4, 2017 at 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. Please refer to Enclosure No. 2 for the members of the Regional Technical Working Group (RTWG).

7. A registration fee of Five Hundred Fifty Pesos (₱550.00) shall be collected from each participant to be paid in cash to the host division, charged against local funds/journalism funds or any available funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing policies/rules and regulations. This will cover honoraria of judges, trophies, kits, supplies, and other operational expenses. Meals of the participants shall be taken care of by their own division.

8. The host division shall be responsible on the purchase of supplies and materials needed during the contest proper, honoraria of judges, transportation allowance of the technical working group, water supply and electric current used in the billeting schools etc. The division shall also responsible in the liquidation of collected registration fee from the eight (1) divisions.

9. The main participants to this conference are the Top 5 Division Winners and Coaches in each of the eight (8) categories of the Individual Writing Contests, team winners and coaches of both Radio Scriptwriting & Broadcasting contest, TV Scriptwriting & Broadcasting contest and the Collaborative Publishing Contest in the two levels and of the two media, totaling to three thousand two hundred (3,200) participants. The breakdown of participants per Division is as follows:

8 individual contest categories x 5 winners x 2 levels x 2 media	=160
7 contestants (Radio Script Writing and Broadcasting) x 2 levels x 2 media	= 28
7 contestants (TV Script Writing and Broadcasting) x 2 media	= 14
7 contestants (Collaborative Desktop Publishing) x 2 levels x 2 media	= 28
Coaches/School Paper Advisers	=170

TOTAL: 400

10. The School Paper Advisers and Campus Journalists are advised to pay their membership the amount of sixty pesos (₱60.00) and thirty pesos (₱30.00) respectively to the Division Treasurers of their respective associations and to be submitted to the treasurer of the Regional Elementary and Secondary School Paper Advisers Association (RESSPAA).

11. The Implementation Guidelines for the Conduct of the Group Contests, Individual Contests, Collaborative Publishing Contest, Photojournalism Contest, Scriptwriting and Radio Broadcasting Contest and Scriptwriting and TV Broadcasting contest are attached in Enclosure No. 1.

12. Transportation and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged against local and other available funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.


13. Top 5 Winners from the National Schools Press Conference shall be given cash incentives based on the following:

- a. Individual Writing Contests: first-₱2,500; second-₱2,000; third-₱1,500; fourth-₱1,000; fifth-₱700 (for both coaches and students)
- b. Group Writing Contests & School Paper Contest: first-₱7,000 for students and ₱3,000 for coach; second-₱5,500 for students and ₱2,500 for coach; third-₱4,000 for students and ₱2,000 for coach; fourth-₱2,500 for students and ₱1,500 for coach; fifth-₱2,000 for students and ₱1,000 for coach

14. A two (2) day compensatory overtime credit or compensatory time-offs (COCs/CTO) shall be granted to the Technical Working Group (TWG) composed of teaching and non-teaching personnel in lieu for December 2 & 3, 2017, Saturday and Sunday.
