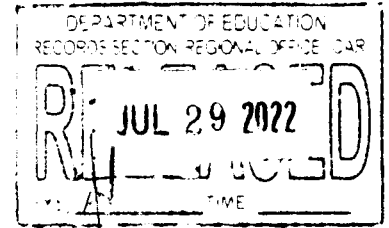

1. Relative to Regional Memorandum No. 329, s. 2022 on the adjusted timeliness on the conduct of the 2021 NQESH, and Regional Memorandum No. 335, s. 2022 on the participants in the conduct of the final coaching activity for DepEd-CAR NQESH examinees, all the NQESH examinees should take note of the following changes:

- A. the NQESH on July 31, 2022 will be administered online at the different SDOs of the respective examinees.
- B. The examinees may be accommodated at the RO for the NQESH only if their respective SDO has weak internet connectivity.
- C. ALL SDO Information Technology Officers (ITOs) and DTCs/NQESH coordinators will serve as the SDO Technical Working Group (TWG) and must be at the SDO testing place on July 31, 2022 to provide technical assistance and support to their examinees. Enclosed is the list of SDO TWG.
- D. The Office of the Assistant Regional Director will serve as the Regional Command Center.
