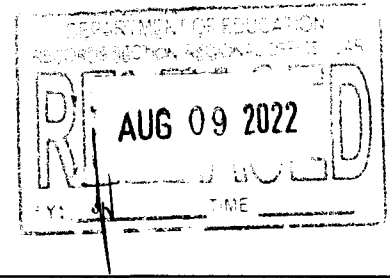

1. In adherence to the DO No. 1, s. 2020ⁱ, DO No. 30, s. 2021ⁱⁱ and DM No. 50, s. 2020ⁱⁱⁱ, the Project GLOW in DepEd CAR shall conduct its Phase 2 to discuss important updates and develop Recognized Professional Development Programs and Courses to address the low turnout in the Region.

2. The purpose of this activity shall address the following objectives:
- a. To develop professional development programs / courses to address the development priorities and emerging needs of teachers and school leaders;
