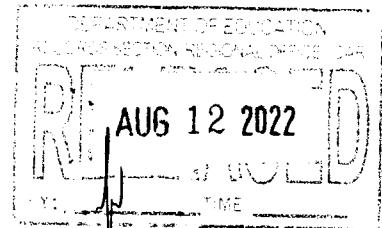

CONDUCT OF PROJECT SPARK: SCHOLARSHIP AVAILMENT FOR PRO-ACTIVE AND ADVANCE RE-ENTRY PROJECTS FOR EFFECTIVE KNOWLEDGE APPLICATION

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 68, s. 2009 and RM No. 018, s. 2021, this Office have provided various scholarship opportunities for school leaders, teaching and non-teaching personnel aimed to address systematic program of career and professional development to support the continuous capacity and capability development of its manpower.
2. As a mechanism to ensure that scholarship grants as well as Re-Entry Projects (REP) are proactively implemented and are systemically advancing in response to professional development standards and contextual needs of personnel, this Office shall conduct the **DepED CAR Project SPARK**, comprised of the following phases:
 - a. Phase 1: Tracking of Scholars and Identification of Re-Entry Projects;
 - b. Phase 2: Benchmarking on Best Practices in the Implementation of REPs and Writeshop for the Development of Phase 3 Criteria; and
 - c. Phase 3: Search for the Best Implemented Scholar's REP.
3. In this connection, each SDO shall assign the Scholarship Coordinator to perform the following:
 - a. Accomplish the Scholars Re-Entry Project Status Report (Enclosure 1) accessible via <https://tinyurl.com/DepEdCARspark> to include all scholars (CO/ RO/ SDO/ Other Government Agency Funded from FY 2020 to present);
 - b. Identify one (1) scholar who is deemed by the SDO to have been successful in the implementation of his/ her Re-Entry Project as presenter during the conduct of Phase 1;
 - c. Submit the signed status report and identified presenter with the subject "ProjectSPARK" to car.neapr@deped.gov.ph **before August 16, 2022**.
