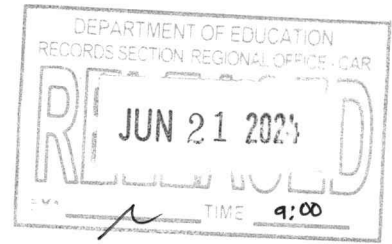

REQUEST FOR THE GLOBAL POSITIONING SYSTEM (GPS) COORDINATES OF PRIVATE SCHOOLS FOR THE GOVERNMENT ASSISTANCE AND SUBSIDIES PROGRAM

1. Pursuant to Memorandum OM-OUPS-2024-13-04763 dated June 13, 2024, on the **REQUEST FOR THE GLOBAL POSITIONING SYSTEM (GPS) COORDINATES OF PRIVATE SCHOOLS FOR THE GOVERNMENT ASSISTANCE AND SUBSIDIES PROGRAM**, this office requests to provide the Global Positioning System (GPS) coordinates of the list of private schools that can be accessed through <https://rb.gy/b13okj>.
2. This aims to map the private schools that shall help decongest public Junior High Schools (JHS) and Senior High Schools (SHS) as one of the GAS Program objectives stated in DepEd Order No. 20, s. 2017 for the Education Contracting Service (ESC) and DepEd Order No. 20, s. 2023 for Senior High School Voucher Program (SHS VP).
3. The use of DepEd email is required to download the information using the link given in No. 1. Select the school's division office, then provide the following information on the last two (2) columns, **Latitude¹ and Longitude²**.
4. The latitude and longitude can also be gathered using Google Maps, following the steps in the link: <https://bitly.cx/8vfrO>:
 - a. Open Google Maps.
 - b. Indicate the physical address from the search bar and press enter for the Google map to locate.
 - c. After locating, right-click the place or area on the map.
 - This will open a pop-up window. You can find the latitude and longitude in decimal format at the top.
 - d. To copy the coordinates automatically, left click on the latitude and longitude.

- The first decimal number is the latitude and the second is the longitude.
5. Submit the requested information by Friday, July 19, 2024, to car.qad@deped.gov.ph to ensure the completeness of the submissions from all SDOs.
