



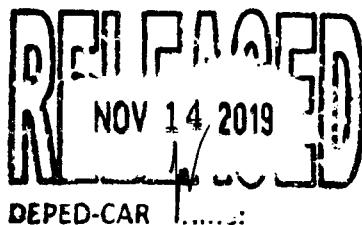

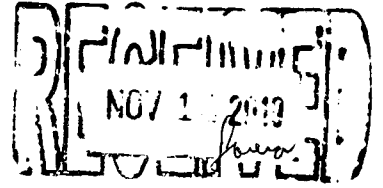

This is about the **2019 School Mental Health Forum** on November 24-27, 2019, being organized by the Bureau of Learner Support Services-School Health Division (BLSS-SHD). The venue for the forum is the **Southview Hotel, Dumaguete City** (<https://www.facebook.com/SouthviewHotelDNJ181Building/>). The Opening Program on November 25 will start at exactly 8 a.m. Attached is the working program for ready reference.

It is reiterated that the check-in and registration will be at the hotel's front desk on November 24 at 2 p.m. Forum participants will be roomed in sex-segregated rooms on triple sharing, and on a first-come, first served basis. No reservation of rooms will be allowed for participants who have not yet arrived at the venue. Meals shall be provided to all participants from lunch of November 24 to breakfast of November 27.

Participants are advised that the 24th day of November of every year is a special holiday in Dumaguete City in observance of its charter day. Participants are free to explore the city on this day. There shall also be an *optional* guided tour with mental health reflective exercises in the morning of November 27. Participants will be requested upon registration to signify their interest and availability to join the said guided tour.

Regions that include learner-participants in their delegation are expected to ensure that all necessary documents, including parent's permit and/or waiver, are secured before attending the forum.

All participants are advised to wear a green top (shirt, blouse, polo, etc.) on the second day of the forum.
