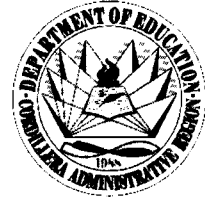

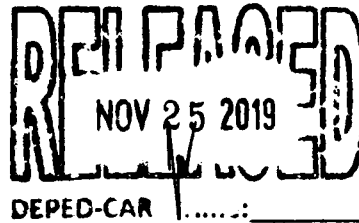


ADDENDUM AND CORRIGENDUM TO RM No. 138, s. 2019 (2019 REGIONAL ACADEMIC FESTIVAL)

- B) Contest packages will not be attached in this memorandum considering its volume. However, copies of contest packages emailed and distributed to SDOs and EPS-EPP/TLE shall be in effect. except those that were revised as agreed upon during the planning meetings.
- C) All tools, equipment, instruments and materials to be used during the competition shall be shouldered by the contestants except in multiple root stock and assexual propagation where host Division shall provide the seedlings/stocks to be payed by the contestants.
- D) Host school shall provide the contest venues and heavy and bulky equipment such as tables, Sewing machines, oven, gas range, desktop computers and other facilities including booth for bazaar.
- E) SDOs shall submit five (5) questions per category (easy, average and difficult), per level, (elementary and secondary) a total of thirty (30) questions per SDO for the Techno-Quiz. Said questions properly labeled, with answers shall be submitted through email at clemente.bandao@deped.gov.ph on or before November 22, 2019.
