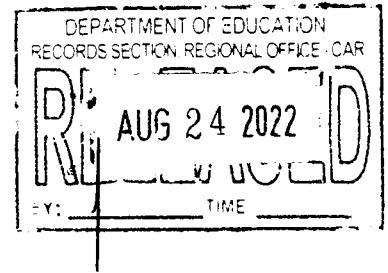

PRO-ACTIVE AND ADVANCE RE-ENTRY PROJECTS FOR EFFECTIVE
KNOWLEDGE APPLICATION)**

1. Relative to RM No. 399, s. 2022 on the Conduct of DepEd CAR SPARK, this Office shall conduct **Phase 1: Presentation of ReEntry Projects on October 3 to 5, 2022** in a blended mode.
2. This phase generally aims to present the best practices carried out by scholars who have successfully implemented their ReEntry Projects in relation to delivery of quality basic education. Specifically, it shall enable other participants to:
 - a. Develop productive strategies from facilitating and hindering factors shared by presenters;
 - b. Establish professional network for coaching and mentoring towards successful implementation of REP; and
 - c. Appreciate the importance of stakeholder involvement towards realization of long-term PD goals.
