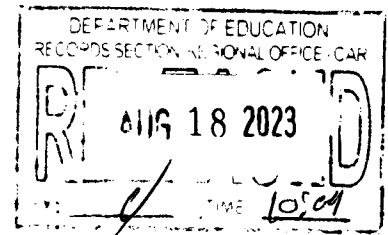

CONDUCT OF PNU-LISQUP MIDYEAR IMPACT STUDY

1. Pursuant to Memorandum DM-OUHROD-2023-1032 and Advisory, the Project Development Team of the Philippine Normal University (PNU) for linking Standards and Quality Practice (LiSQuP), together with the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) will conduct a face-to-face Midyear Impact Study in the Region from August 31-September 2, 2023, as the program is currently on its Academic 3.2.
2. The activities include:
 - a. Focus Group Discussion-required for select scholars;
 - b. Research Clinic – not required but open to all scholars, especially those who need consultation;
 - c. Training Session on HOTS – not required, but open to 100 scholars and non-LiSQuP scholars on a first come, first serve basis; and
 - d. Informant's Interview - PDT and NEAP visitation and interview to 66 scholars' immediate supervisor.
3. The main objective of the activity is to examine the midterm impact of the LiSQuP program on select LiSQuP scholars. Specifically, the activity aims to:
 - a. Describe the impact of the LiSQuP program from the lens of both the scholars and the immediate supervisors;
 - b. Determine the challenges, opportunities, career aspirations and other experiences of the LiSQuP scholars;
 - c. Formulate inputs on the LiSQuP model based on the findings of the study;
 - d. Report the findings of the midterm impact study to the Regional and Division NEAP focal persons and DepEd leaders.
4. The expected activities are indicated in Enclosure 1. Identified participants are in Enclosure 2; implementation dates and venues are in Enclosure 3 and Program Activities are in Enclosure 4.
5. Food and accommodation shall be provided to select LiSQuP scholars and PMT members; while, travel expenses, per diem, and other incidental expenses shall be charged to Local Funds.
