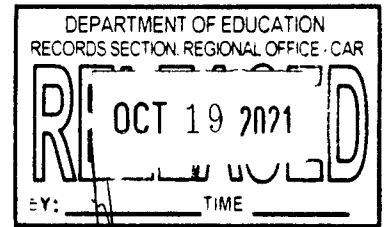

EXECUTIVE ORDER

NO. 115- 2021

AN ORDER SUSPENDING WORK IN GOVERNMENT OFFICES ON OCTOBER 12, 2021 IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF LA TRINIDAD, BENGUET

WHEREAS, heavy rains and strong winds brought about by TS "MARING" are presently impacting the region;

WHEREAS, around 2:00 pm today, PAG-ASA – DOST raised the alert level to Orange where rainfall is between 15 mm and 30 mm within one hour, and is poised to cause serious flooding and soil saturation;

WHEREAS, as of 7:46 pm today, October 11, 2021, power outages, flooding, landslides and other erosions, including injuries, have been reported in various areas of the Municipality;

WHEREAS, threats to life, property and infrastructure subsist due to the continuous strong rains and gusty winds;

WHEREAS, in order to allow government personnel to secure their lives and property, and likewise focus their utmost attention to securing lives and property and attending to various emergencies, there arises the need to suspend work in government offices, encouraging the private sector to do the same, tomorrow October 12, 2021 in the Municipality of La Trinidad;

NOW THEREFORE, by virtue of the powers vested in me as Municipal Mayor of La Trinidad, I, **ROMEO K. SALDA**, do hereby **SUSPEND WORK IN GOVERNMENT OFFICES ON OCTOBER 12, 2021 IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF LA TRINIDAD, BENGUET**.

Section 1. Offices providing medical and emergency services – particularly, the MDRMO, Municipal Engineering Office, General Services Office, MSWDO and MHSO, including the La Trinidad Operations Center – shall be open on skeleton workforce to provide services and attend to medical and other emergencies;

Section 2. All Barangays must assign personnel to respond to calls or emergencies.
