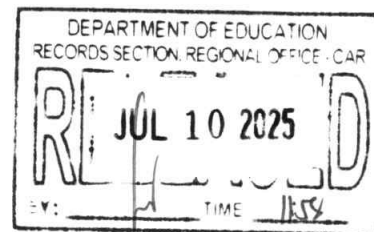

CONDUCT OF THE BEGINNING-OF-SCHOOL-YEAR (BOSY) ASSESSMENTS

To: Assistant Regional Director
Schools Division Superintendents
All Others Concerned

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 012, s. 2025, Multi-year Implementing Guidelines on the school calendar and activities, the beginning-of-school-year (BOSY) administration of the Comprehensive Rapid Literacy Assessment (CRLA), Rapid Mathematics Assessment (RMA) and Philippine Informal Reading Inventory (Phil-IRI), is scheduled from June 16 to July 16, 2025.

2. All schools are required to conduct the results of assessments on or before July 31, 2025 in the submission link below:

3. For the CRLA and Phil-IRI, this office provides the following guidelines on the language/s to be used:

- a. For Grade 1 (whichever is applicable)
Mother Tongue (MT) for learners whose first language (L1) is not Filipino and the learner's MT has CRLA tool; or,
Filipino for learners who speak Filipino, or learners whose language does not currently have a CRLA tool.
- b. For Grade 2
Mother Tongue (MT) – according to the MT used by the school for Grade 1 learners in SY 2024-2025, if the MT has a CRLA tool; and
Filipino – for all learners
- c. For Grade 3
Filipino for all learners; and,
English for all learners.

4. For Phil-IRI, all learners from Grades 4 to 10 shall take both English and Filipino assessment. Teachers are reminded to use the appropriate assessment tool corresponding to the language being assessed.
5. The supervisors concerned should monitor the submission of the CRLA, RMA and Phil-IRI to ensure one hundred percent submission in all SDOs.
