

UPDATES ON THE INVITATION TO THE JOINT ONLINE LEARNING SESSION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND SEAMEO INNOTECH TITLED "UNDERSTANDING PRINCIPALSHIP IN SCHOOLS: SHARING PRACTICES IN PRINCIPAL PREPARATION, SELECTION, DEVELOPMENT IN SOUTHEAST ASIA

- 1. Relative to DM-OULS-2025-025 titled Invitation to the Joint Online Learning Session of the Department of Education and SEAMEO Innotech titled "Understanding Principalship in Schools: Sharing Practices in Principal Preparation, Selection, and Development in Southeast Asia, this office calls for participation of HRDD chiefs and HRDD supervisors in charge of school heads selection, preparation and development on the said online activity.
- 2. The Education Center for Artificial Intelligence Research (ECAIR), a pioneering partnership between the Department of Education and SEAMEO INNOTECH, advances data science and AI applications in education, with a specific focus on strengthening principalship development through data and analytics. Under ECAIR, the SIKAP Project (Strengthening and Improving the Knowledge Advancement of Aspiring Principals) seeks to understand the readiness of aspiring school leaders by examining the leadership pipeline, field practices, and international models, ultimately informing data-driven strategies for leadership development and succession planning. To foster regionally rooted, data-driven, and evidence-informed practices in principalship development, a **regional Learning and Knowledge Sharing Session** shall be conducted on **August 27** via Zoom.
- 3. The objectives of these free learning sessions are:
 - a. to learn from recent findings of UNESCO's Global Education Monitoring (GEM) Report (*School Heads Chapter*) and EDCOM 2 Report.
 - b. to exchange knowledge on regional practices in school leadership preparation, selection, training, and development.
 - c. to co-develop regional reflections and recommendations on strengthening principal development pathways.
- 4. The expected participants of the learning sessions are:
 - a. Regional Directors and/or Assistant Regional Directors or their assigned alternates
 - b. HRDD Chiefs and/or HRDD Supervisors in charge of School Heads selection, preparation, and development
