





- In reference to DM-OUOPS-2025-11-01288, the Learner Rights and Protection Division (LRPD), in collaboration with the Curriculum and Teaching Strand and Stairway Foundation, Inc. proposes the conduct of a classroom-based learning session to increase awareness against OSAEC and CSAEM through integration in appropriate subject areas its core messages at the elementary and secondary levels.
- All schools are required to implement an instructional classroom-based session of the anti-OSAEC and CSAEM for each key stage, which shall be delivered by class advisers during their Homeroom subject. The classroom-based session shall be delivered during any day in March.

- To ensure the effectiveness and efficiency of the activity, schools shall accomplish the classroom-level and school-level forms after the implementation of the activity. Teacher designates and guidance advocates handling learner disclosure are requested to complete the non-disclosure agreement. - Further, schools shall submit the completed forms to the Schools Division 5. Office. The Schools Division Offices, through the Division Learner Rights and Protection Focal Person, shall consolidate the forms submitted by schools using the SDO Level Form, which can be accessed at the same link. The SDO Level Form shall be submitted to the Regional Office on or before April 7, 2025.



In compliance with Presidential Proclamation No. 417 "Declaring the Second Tuesday of February of Every Year as Safer Internet Day for Children [in the] Philippines," and in line with the promulgation of the Implementing Rules and Regulation (IRR) of Republic Act No. 11930, entitled "An Act Punishing Online Sexual Abuse or Exploitation of Children (OSAEC) and Anti-Child Sexual Abuse or Exploitation Materials (CSAEM)," the Department of Education (DepEd) is mandated to ensure the implementation of anti-OSAEC and CSAEM policy in schools through its Learner Rights and Protection Division (LRPD). In line thereto, the LRPD in collaboration with the Curriculum and Teaching Strand and in partnership with the Stairway Foundation Inc. proposes the conduct of a classroom-based learning session to increase awareness against OSAEC and CSAEM through integration in appropriate subject areas its core messages at the elementary and secondary levels.

These learning sessions will directly reach our learners, equipping them with knowledge and tools and increasing their awareness against OSAEC and CSAEM. The session guides can be accessed through this link: https://tinyurl.com/2025AntiOSAECDraft.

Moreover, to ensure the implementation of anti-OSAEC and CSAEM policies in Schools, an instructional classroom-based session of the anti-OSAEC and CSAEM shall be conducted for each key stage and shall be delivered by the class advisers during their Homeroom subject. The classroom-based session shall be delivered during any day of March.

To ensure the effectiveness and efficiency of the conduct of the said activity, the different governance levels are expected to answer the data collection forms. Accordingly, in compliance with the Data Privacy Act, teacher-designates and guidance advocates who will be handling learner disclosure are requested to fill out the non-disclosure agreement. "Localized Take it Down Campaign" which aims to enable our learners to proactively request the removal or prevention of explicit images or videos online through a secure and confidential platform. This initiative is integrated into the existing classroom-based session guides on OSAEC and CSAEM.

Further, to monitor the implementation of the program, as well as lead in the conversation with learners and school personnel to combat OSAEC and CSAEM, this Office, through the LRPD requests the conduct of a scheduled "Take it Down Conversations." The proposed schedule for which may be seen below:

To ensure that learners' classes are not unnecessarily disrupted, the LRPD proposes that the LRP on Wheels be conducted simultaneously with the scheduled "Take it Down Conversations" for each identified area. The Regional Offices are asked to identify one (1) school for hosting the activity and to select two hundred (200) junior high school learners to participate. It is also requested that the chosen school have a canteen where our partners can request snacks for our participants, the cost of which shall be covered by our partners.
