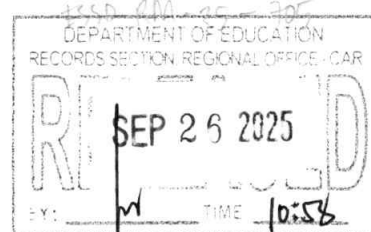

2025 REGIONAL CLIMATE CHANGE CARAVAN

To: Assistant Regional director

1. The 2025 Regional Climate Change Caravan is an annual event conducted by the Department of Education. It aims to raise awareness and engage learners, teachers, and personnel in climate change adaptation & mitigation, environmental protection, disaster risk reduction, and related environmental education.
2. This year's activity will be conducted in selected schools per division and will be conducted within October and November. Activities for the caravan are, but not limited to the following:
 - a. climate change orientation;
 - b. presentation of lesson exemplars integrated with concepts on climate change; and
 - c. engagement with learners through the TIKTOC Climate Talk board game.
3. The amount of Ten Thousand Pesos (PhP 10,000.00) shall be downloaded per division for the conduct of the caravan. Allowable activities for the downloaded funds are the following:
 - a. Meals and snacks of participants during the activity
 - b. Contingency to cover payment of miscellaneous expenses, incidental expenses to the conduct of the activities (prizes, tokens, supplies and materials, etc)
4. The division DRRM coordinator, together with the school head shall facilitate the conduct of the activity. Identified schools where the caravan will be conducted are indicated below. Schedule of the caravan will be announced later.
