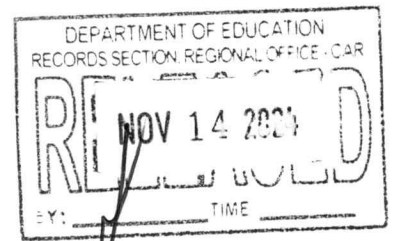

**CONDUCT OF 42ND PRINCIPALS TRAINING AND DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM CUM NATIONAL BOARD CONFERENCE (PTDB-NBC) OF THE PHILIPPINE ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS PRINCIPALS ASSOCIATIONS (PESPA)**

1. The PESPA shall conduct the **42nd Principals Training and Development Program cum National Board Conference (PTDP-NBC)** from **23-25 April 2025** at the IEC Convention Center, Cebu, Pope John Paul II, Avenue 23 Minore Park, corner Cardinal Rosales Avenue, Cebu City.
2. The conference, bearing the theme “Innovative Pedagogies and Technologies in the 21st Century Education: A Breakthrough in MATATAG Curriculum,” aims to:
  - a. strengthen research and innovation for school heads;
  - b. improve teaching competencies through innovation in giving support;
  - c. craft technical assistance tool for coaching and mentoring; and
