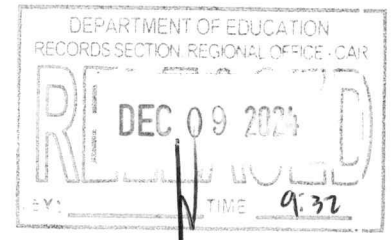

PARTICIPATION TO THE NATIONAL SUMMIT OF THE MATATAG CURRICULUM IMPLEMENTERS

1. The Curriculum and Teaching Strand shall conduct the **National Summit of the MATATAG Curriculum Implementers** on December 9-11, 2024 in the National Capital Region. A separate advisory shall be issued regarding the venue.
2. The activity aims to:
 - a. consolidate issues and concerns that have confronted the field implementers, particularly the classroom teachers, in the implementation of the MATATAG curriculum;
 - b. discuss ways to sustain the strengths and address the challenges in the curriculum implementation; and
 - c. foster synchronized mechanism of support for the MATATAG Curriculum implementation across all levels of governance.

The AVP shall be sent to **car.clmd@deped.gov.ph** copy furnished to **noverkeithley.mente@deped.gov.ph** on or before **December 6, 2024**.
6. To ensure that the concerned teachers will be able to attend the Summit, school heads are expected to employ strategies suitable for the classes, such as but not limited to, maximizing the load of relieving teachers to handle the classes while the teachers are in the National Summit of the MATATAG Curriculum of Pilot Implementers.
7. Board and lodging, supplies, materials and travel expenses of participants shall be charged against 2023 BEC Continuing Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing
