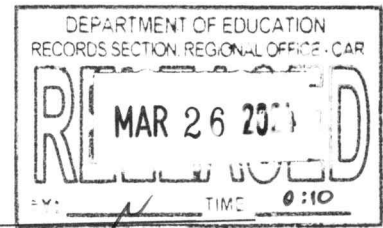

BASIC EDUCATION RESEARCH FUND (BERF) GRANT**

1. In adherence to DepEd Memorandum No. 16, s. 2017, "*The Research Management Guidelines*", the Regional Research Committee (RRC) is mandated to screen, evaluate, and approve research proposals from the schools, community Learning Centers, Schools Division Offices (SDOs), and Regional Office for possible fund grant under the Basic Education Research Fund (BERF).
2. Relative hereto, this office, through the RRC and Policy, Planning, and Research Division (PPRD), after having conducted the screening and evaluation of research proposals, announces the attached shortlisted Action Research and Basic Research Studies for the 2024 BERF Grant.
3. Division Research Coordinators shall attend a virtual meeting on **April 2, 2024, 9:00 a.m.** via MS Teams through the link <https://bit.ly/ResearchMeeting24>. The meeting aims to orient and provide technical assistance to the research coordinators relative to the submission of a memorandum of agreement (MOA) and the completion of research documents and liquidation reports.
4. All enclosed BERF grantees are required to submit a hard copy of the following requirements compiled in an A4 white folder to the SDO Research Coordinator, which shall be forwarded to the DepEd CAR, Policy, Planning, and Research Division, Wangal, La Trinidad, Benguet, on or before **April 8, 2024**, for the processing and downloading of funds:

- a. Application form and endorsement of Immediate Supervisor of the Proponent
- b. Approval Sheet
- c. Final Research Proposal
- d. Anti-plagiarism and absence of conflict-of-Interest Declaration
- e. Evaluation Checklist
- f. Colored photocopy of Landbank ATM Card; and
- g. Signed copy of Memorandum of Agreement (MOA)
