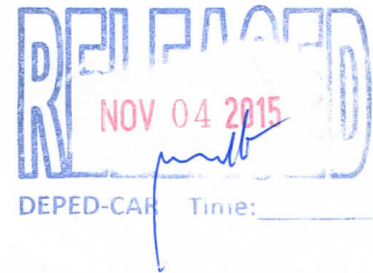

SUBJECT: **ANTI-DENGUE CAMPAIGN IN SCHOOLS REGION-WIDE**

Date: **November 3, 2015**



1. Due to the increasing number of Dengue Cases in the region as well as nationwide, the Department of Education, Cordillera Administrative Region in collaboration with all concern to strengthen campaign against Dengue in order to protect the school populace and the community. Thus, everyone is urgently requested to support the campaign on dengue preventive and control through cleaning of our respective schools/offices at least every Friday at 4 0'clock P.M. starting November 6, 2015 and onwards.
2. Per Unnumbered DepED Memo dated October 26, 2015, re: Implementation of Brigada Kalinisan and Dengue Prevention Campaign, all school will conduct the wide cleaning program anytime of the day from October 2-8, 2015. **For CAR, let us launch Brigada Kalinisan simultaneously on November 6, 2015 at 4' 0 clock P.M.**
3. The following suggested activities are to be done by everyone to ensure all school facilities will be thoroughly clean:
  - a. Change water of flower vases and scrub side of containers once a week
  - b. Cover all water containers well and other containers which can accumulate water or turn it upside down when not in use
  - c. Disposal of all used tin cans and other useless containers
  - d. Dispose garbage properly and remove rubbish around premises
  - e. Inspect and clean roof gutters regularly
  - f. Discard unused tires properly or put soil to all discarded tires
  - g. Water canals must be cleaned at all times
  - h. Under the tables, chairs and cabinets shall also be cleaned
4. All Schools Division Superintendents with your respective health and nutrition personnel are hereby instructed to coordinate with the schools heads to identify critical areas of high dengue incidence for the provision of Insecticide Treated Nets/Screens from the Department of Health.
5. The Divisions/schools must have a Surveillance Team on Dengue Cases and to designate a Dengue Coordinator to closely monitor those learners and facilitators affected with Dengue.
6. All schools are likewise instructed to submit reports on the implementation of the school-wide cleaning program to their respective Schools Division Offices and the School Division Offices to Regional Office, at the ESSD on or before November 30, 2015
7. For strict compliance.
