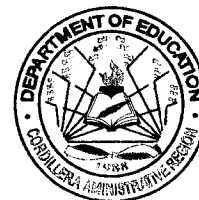

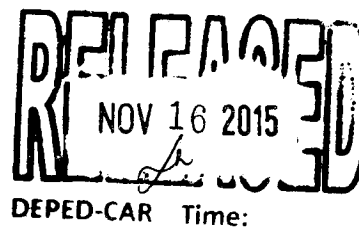

SUBJECT: Training-Workshop on the Identification of Local IKSPs and Integration in the IP Core Curriculum of the Alternative Learning System



1. Relative to the indigenization of the Alternative Learning System (ALS) Curriculum, a three-day training-workshop on the identification and integration of local IKSPs in the Indigenous Peoples Core Curriculum will be conducted at the NEAP-R Hall, DepEd-CAR on December 7 - 9, 2015.
2. The training-workshop aims for the participants to:
  - a) identify the IKSPs that can be adapted/adopted in the different divisions of CAR;
  - b) identify the entry points of local IKSPs in the six learning strands of ALS; and
  - c) develop sample Curriculum Webs and Briefs for Alternative Learning System (Basic Literacy Level).
