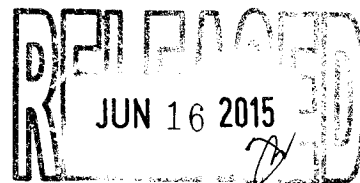

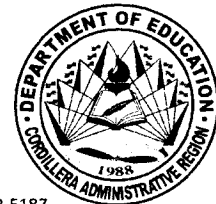
The profile of a person blowing a "tangguyob" represents a community being called for an important matter or action.
