

- Immediate dissemination is requested.



The University of the Cordilleras College of Teacher Education has once again been designated by the National Center for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) as a Level 1 Implementer of the Graduate Degree for Cultural Education (GDCE) program in the Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR). GDCE is a post-graduate program leading to a Master's degree in Cultural Education. The program shall be conducted on April 11, 2016 - May 11, 2016. Selected scholars of the program shall enjoy free tuition fee for the twenty-four unit course (twelve units for Level 1 and 12 units for Level 2), and a stipend of five-thousand pesos (P5,000.00) per summer term.

In view of this, may we request assistance from your good office to help invite prospective scholars from CAR for the program? Those interested to avail of the scholarship shall submit or send to the Dean of the College of Teacher Education, University of the Cordilleras their Official Transcript of Records (or a soft copy of the OTR which can be sent to this email address: lettyepistola@yahoo.com) and an endorsement letter from their school heads until January 31, 2016. Only thirty-five scholars will be selected for the program.

We shall be informing your office the final list of scholars on or before March 30, 2016.
